



**Jesus Changes Everything!  
Philippians 3**

5. I want to \_\_\_\_\_ Christ-yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead (Philippians 3:10-11).  
  
I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is \_\_\_\_\_ and to die is \_\_\_\_\_ (Philippians 1:20-21).
6. Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I \_\_\_\_\_ to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me (Philippians 3:12).
7. Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. \_\_\_\_\_: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward if Christ Jesus (Philippians 3:13-14).  
  
Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and is now seated at the right hand of the throne of God (Hebrews 12:2).
8. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God (II Corinthians 5:16-20).

But occasionally, something happens that does the unthinkable. It makes us change what we \_\_\_\_\_.
2. If someone else thinks they have reasons to put confidence in the flesh, I have more: circumcised on the eighth day (dream \_\_\_\_\_), of the people of Israel (dream \_\_\_\_\_), of the tribe of Benjamin (dream \_\_\_\_\_), a Hebrew of Hebrews (dream \_\_\_\_\_); in regard to the law, a Pharisee (dream \_\_\_\_\_); as for zeal, persecuting the church (dream \_\_\_\_\_); as for righteousness based on the law, faultless (dream \_\_\_\_\_) (Philippians 3:4-6).
3. But whatever were \_\_\_\_\_ to me I now consider \_\_\_\_\_ for the sake of Christ (Philippians 3:7).

But whatever were gains to me I now consider loss for the sake of Christ (Philippians 3:7).
4. What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them \_\_\_\_\_, that I may gain Christ and be found in him. (Philippians 3:8-9)
