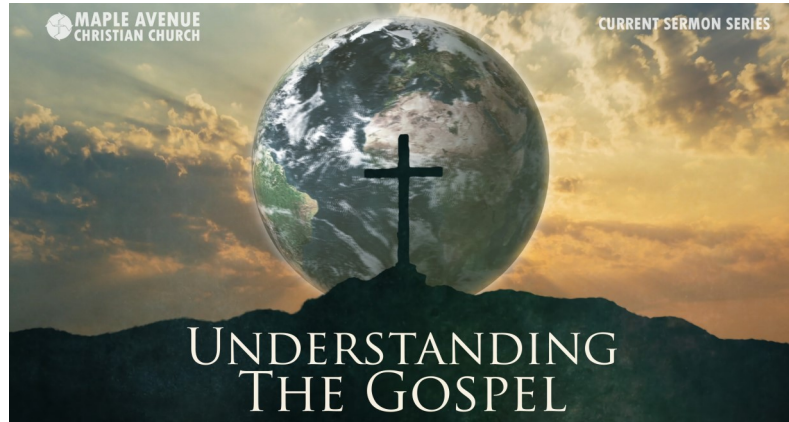
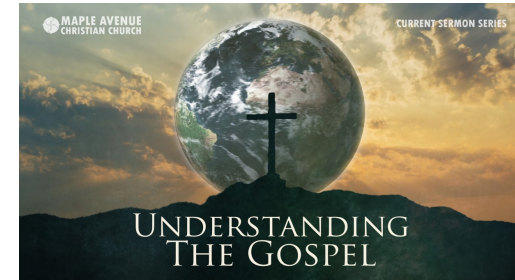


**QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUPS/
